INTRODUCTION

Presenting itself as visceral pain located in the lower right portion of the abdomen, in addition to other associated symptoms, acute appendicitis (AA) occurs as an inflammatory condition, in which there is obstruction of the lumen of the intestinal appendix by several factors, such as the accumulation of hard feces and the appearance of tumors. Therefore, it is known that this pathology is potentially fatal, as disruption of this intestinal portion tends to cause a generalized infection, making emergency care necessary to prevent the progression of this condition. Thus, the discussion in scientific circles about emergency surgical interventions has, in this pathology, great relevance in establishing the well-being of affected individuals;
